

IOWSAB - MARM for Managers - Virtual Training Trainer Feedback

- It is an overarching framework, participants recognised that they all needed to develop their own agency business processes (is there a role for the SAB here via QA&P Sub-Group).
- Need to remind all partners that this framework is about working with adults where there is an unmanageable level of risk as a result of circumstances which create risk of harm for a critical few cases.
- Participants realised that the framework is there to aid decision making, but that professional judgement will determine whether the level of risk has reached an unmanageable level for the organisation and there will be different professional judgements, but that is ok as the framework might help to gain more clarity, shared understanding or equally reflect differences.
- Need to remind all partners that any agency can initiate.
- This framework is not instead of a S42 enquiry but can refer to if safeguarding concerns criteria met.
- This framework supports working with adults with capacity.
- Need to have in place risk assessment and information sharing processes – to gain a holistic overview of the risks Refer to page 11 of the Framework.
- Principle of 'no delay' should be applied.
- Promote wellbeing, person centred, strength based, choice, control, solution focussed, MSP.
- A whole approach – involving family, friends, communities, professionals.
- Adults have the right to refuse to participate.
- Lots of supporting tools and templates are available, but additional tools would be useful, particularly a prompt tool to aid decision making that would also act as a recording tool.
